# Adagio<sup>®</sup> Cloud Client 9.2A (2016.02.17)

## **Enhancements & Revisions in Cloud Client**

• Allows components to be auto-updated to the client computer from Adagio Cloud servers.

NOTE: This version is required for compatibility with Adagio Cloud. It must be installed or you will not be able to access Adagio Cloud when changes are made on the servers.

#### Installing

To install Adagio Cloud Client you need the Host Name from the instruction email sent to you by Softrak Systems.

To install Adagio Cloud Client, run the program file you downloaded. Once the install program is running, you can click the Readme button for installation instructions.

Optionally during installation you can enter the User Name and Password if known. Entering the User Name and Password fields will embed them in the resulting Desktop shortcut. Without the user name and password in the shortcut you will have to enter them every time you start Adagio Cloud, or until such time as your system administrator updates your shortcut.

Click the Update Shortcut checkbox if you only want to update the information in the shortcut but do not want to update the Client program. Normally the checkbox will be left blank which will update the Client program as well.

The Adagio Cloud Client will install the Host provider's Client in your user folder under the Users folder on your computer. It will also install any of its own files to C:\Softrak\System\Cloud.

### **Supported Modules**

Adagio Cloud supports Adagio 9.2A modules available for hosting.

DataCare has the ability to run a program or command batch file on success/fail of a job and has a browse to such files. This is not permitted in DataCare running hosted on Adagio Cloud and these options are disabled in the Company Profile.

DataCare has the ability to backup specific files/folders (with wildcards). This is not permitted in DataCare running hosted on Adagio Cloud and these options are disabled in the Company Profile.
