## Installing

To install Adagio DataCare from the Adagio Product CD you need the serial number and install code from the Product Label that came with your CD.

To install Adagio DataCare, insert the CD in the drive. If the install program does not start automatically, run ADAGIO.EXE from the root of the CD. Or, if Adagio DataCare was downloaded, run the program file you downloaded. Once the install program is running, you can click the View button to open the Readme file for detailed instructions. If Adagio DataCare is installed on a network, you must also do a workstation install for each workstation running Adagio DataCare. Refer to "Installing on a network" in the Readme for instructions.

## **Compatibility Notes**

DataCare supports the "Application Integrity Check" phase for the applications shown in the above compatibility chart and marked with an asterisk. For all other applications, DataCare supports the "File Integrity Check" phase where applicable (DataCare is compatible with but there is no database to check for Adagio GridView, Lanpak, OLEDB or Crystal Reports for Adagio).

DataCare supports third party products that use the Adagio Data Source, for which the developer has written a DataCare Data Integrity Check DLL.

## Upgrading to Adagio DataCare from DOS DataCare

DataCare DOS settings are not read and must be reentered.
