## Enhancements in MultiCurrency

- Compatible with and required by version 9.2A and higher releases of Adagio. Downward compatible with earlier versions.
  - Compatible with Adagio xConsole.
  - Uses the current version of the Crystal Reports runtime engine to view and print reports, replacing the Crystal Reports 8.5 Print Engine (CRPE32.dll). Reports have been converted for Crystal Reports 2013 and can be modified with Crystal Reports 2011 or 2013. Custom reports created with Crystal Reports 2011 or 2013 can be added to the Reports menu by placing them in `\Softtrak\MultiCurrency\CustomReports`.
  - The report viewer remembers the window size, position and zoom level. Print/Preview options, including Preview Zoom Factor and Preview Window State (Full screen / Partial screen) were removed from Workstation Options.
  - Installs the AdagioPDF printer driver. All reports and printouts from Adagio can be printed to the AdagioPDF printer to create a PDF document in the data folder.
  - Added User Preferences under the File menu. It allows you to set certain options by user that were previously global, including options previously found under File | Options, Reports | Report Options. You can set the color, add an image, and add text to the main screen of the program. Includes new options 'On Start-up', 'Alphabetically sorted field list' and 'Exclude Ranges'.
- You can now start other Adagio modules from buttons on the toolbar. Buttons show the icon for the module. This option is enabled in User Preferences on the General tab. The buttons are selectable and movable in User Preferences and on the toolbar itself using drag and drop.
  - Added smart finder to Currency Codes and Rate Type fields on edit screens.
  - Grids and finders now show the lookup values instead of the raw data values for typed fields. For example Rate Operation shows: Multiply or Divide instead of M or D; and Date Matching shows Higher, Lower or Exact instead of H, L or E.
  - The Open Data screen can be sized horizontally to allow you to see the full data path. You can now use Alt-B to open the browse and Alt-F (for Favorites) to open the previously opened list. In previous versions you had to use the mouse to select the folder buttons.
  - Alt-X now selects the Excel Direct button on grids where it is available. In previous versions you had to use the mouse to select Excel Direct.
  - Adagio MultiCurrency 9.2A now installs to the `\Softtrak\MultiCurrency` folder and the program name is `MultiCurrency.exe`. Previous versions were installed in `\Softtrak\MCWin`

and had program name MCWin.exe. The install still creates the old folder because Adagio programs with a release date prior to 2014 still check there to determine if Adagio MultiCurrency is installed and licensed before enabling their multi-currency functionality.

## Problems Fixed

- Display of the warning message "That Foreign currency doesn't exist." was not displayed consistently in the Edit Exchange Rates function
- Backup to vitalEsafe did not work in version 8.1B.
- The Edit User function could not be accessed even if it was enabled in a Security Group.
- The Printer name, if long, was displayed on multiple lines instead of just one line on Report dialogs.
- The copy number did not show in the window title when multiple copies of the program were open, for example "Adagio MultiCurrency (2)".

## Installing

To install Adagio MultiCurrency you need the serial number and install code from the download instructions email sent to you by Softrak Systems.

If you are installing an upgrade, you need the serial number and install code from the upgrade download instructions email. A previous version of Adagio MultiCurrency should already be installed on your computer before installing the upgrade. If a previous version is not already installed, you can still install the upgrade. After entering the upgrade serial number and install code, you will also have to enter the serial number and install code from your previous version.

### **Read the 'Upgrading' sections below before installing an upgrade.**

To install Adagio MultiCurrency (or an upgrade), run the program file you downloaded. Once the install program is running, you can click the View button to open the Readme file for detailed instructions.

After installing MultiCurrency or an upgrade, a workstation install may be required at each station running Adagio MultiCurrency on a network. To determine if a workstation install is required, start Adagio MultiCurrency at the workstation. The workstation install will be automatically started if required. Note: If you are updating multiple applications at the same time, it may be faster to run the all workstation install to update all applications at once on the station. Refer to "Installing on a Network" in the Readme for instructions.

Adagio MultiCurrency 9.2A requires Adagio Lanpak (if used) to be version 9.2A or higher.

Adagio MultiCurrency 9.2A requires Microsoft Server 2008 R2 SP1 or higher if running under Remote Desktop Services (Terminal Services). MultiCurrency 9.2A may be installed to Server 2003 and 2008 R1 when used as a file server from a station on a LAN.

# Upgrading

## Upgrading from 8.1B

Upgrade Complexity: **Intermediate** ■

The upgrade can be installed at any time. A minor database conversion taking a few seconds will be performed.

The option 'DataSet will be used concurrently with ACCPAC® Plus™' has been removed from the DataSet Profile function as it is no longer required.

Adagio MultiCurrency 9.2A now installs to the \Softrak\MultiCurrency folder and the program name is MultiCurrency.exe. Previous versions were installed in \Softrak\McWin and had a program name of McWin.exe. The install still creates the old folder because Adagio programs with a release date prior to 2014 still check there to determine if Adagio MultiCurrency is installed and licensed before enabling their multicurrency functionality. When an Adagio MultiCurrency 9.2A upgrade is installed, it automatically uninstalls any prior version of Adagio Multicurrency. The uninstall intentionally leaves the old Softrak\McWin folder and some files within it. The folder and files should not be deleted.

The upgrade install cannot change any custom icons you may have created to launch MultiCurrency and will display a "Problem with Shortcut" error if they are launched. You must change these icons manually to run MultiCurrency from \Softrak\MultiCurrency\MultiCurrency.exe or create new ones.

### Converting GridView Views

GridView views created for earlier versions of Adagio MultiCurrency should be recreated using tables from 'System Currency 9.2A'. GridView has the ability to convert existing views to a new table.

### Converting Modified and Custom Reports

If you have modified any of the standard reports installed by Adagio MultiCurrency, you will have to redo those modifications for MultiCurrency 9.2A. Modified reports are files with a .rpt extension that you copied from \Softrak\McWin\StandardRP to \Softrak\McWin\ModRP and modified using Crystal Reports 8.5 for Adagio. Your modified reports from your prior version will be copied to the folder \Softrak\MultiCurrency\ModifiedReports.priorversion. These same reports must be recopied from \Softrak\MultiCurrency\StandardReports to \Softrak\MultiCurrency\ModifiedReports and re-modified using Crystal Reports 2011 or 2013. **Adagio ODBC must be installed to be able to do this.**

When you are certain the original modified reports are no longer needed, you can delete the \Softrak\McWin\ModRP and \Softrak\MultiCurrency\ModifiedReports.priorversion folders.

Custom reports created in Crystal Reports for Adagio for earlier versions of MultiCurrency will have to be converted or recreated. Your custom reports from your prior version will be copied to the folder \Softrak\MultiCurrency\CustomReports.priorversion. Converted or recreated custom reports must be placed in \Softrak\MultiCurrency\CustomReports.

A Report Converter Utility will be made available from Softrak Systems for the purpose of converting Crystal Reports 7 and 8.5 reports that use the old Crystal Reports Print Engine (CRPE32.dll) to Crystal Reports 2011/2013 format, using the AdagioODBC driver. Converted

reports can be edited and new reports can be created using Crystal Reports 2011 or 2013.  
**Adagio ODBC must be installed to be able to do this.**

Installing a MultiCurrency upgrade does not delete your original custom reports in  
\Softrak\MCWin\CustomRP. When you are certain the original reports are no longer needed,  
you can delete \Softrak\MCWin\CustomRP and  
\Softrak\MultiCurrency\CustomReports.priorversion folders.

**Upgrading from earlier versions**

**Upgrade Complexity:** **Intermediate** ■

The Previously Opened database list is now saved by Adagio User rather than for all users.  
The first time an existing user or a new user logs into Adagio MultiCurrency 9.2A they will  
be asked "Would you like your historical company access list set up?" Answer yes to have  
MultiCurrency add all entries from the Previously Opened list from your prior version. It is  
no longer possible for all users to share the same Previously Opened list.
